



TRANSITION TO SECONDARY Programme Overview

Monday Induction

- The tutor may be more directive;
- Leading the group
- Explain why they are at the centre doing the Transition programme.
- Setting the scene, play name games and 'get to know you' games.
- Discussing Secondary School, what are their expectations / thoughts?



Monday/Tuesday Self

- The tutor will start to guide the group more.
- Supporting the group in becoming more independent, i.e. looking at the timetable together.
- Asking the group, what time they need to be ready, where they should be meeting and what they should be wearing.
- Focusing on the individual and how they can help improve their skills, e.g. listen more or ask more questions, etc.
- Making links with Secondary School, being on time for class, if not what are the consequences, having the correct text books or PE kit etc....



Wednesday/Thursday Others

- Group members encouraged to support others in the group
- The group should be working more independently
- Using the timetable to get to the activity base at the right time with the right equipment and clothing
- Discussing any problems they had in doing the above and how to solve them.
- Working together as a group / solving problems and figuring things out.



Thursday/Friday - School Environment

- Letting the group take more responsibility
- The group taking responsibility to the session and equipment
- They should be able to do things on their own and help each other.
- Activity where they can apply what they have learned over the week.

- The Transition Programme is a 5 day programme running from 10.30 am on Monday to 3.30 am on a Friday.
- Please note that a transition programme can consist of an entire **S1 year group**, who may come in September or October which will be their first month in the Secondary School.
